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Terms of Purchase

1. Validity

These Terms of Purchase form an integral part of all purchase contracts concluded by Ringele AG. Any deviations from these provisions must be agreed upon in writing. Further agreements supersede the present provisions and must also be contractually stipulated. These Terms of Purchase shall apply to all points not mentioned in the separate agreement(s).

By releasing an offer or accepting an order, the supplier accepts the Terms of Purchase. Other terms of sale of the supplier are only valid if they have been expressly acknowledged in writing by Ringele AG. Compliance with Swiss law and applicable the international law forms the basis of the business relationship. These include: REACH (EU Chemicals Ordinance), RoHS (Directive on the Restriction of Hazardous Substances), etc.

2. Orders

Orders from Ringele AG are only binding if they have been put in writing or have been confirmed in writing. As confirmation of an order, we expect a copy of our order to be returned stamped and duly signed.

3. Non-disclosure, confidentiality

Orders from Ringele AG as well as all knowledge concerning technical and commercial matters that are not publically known, such as technical documents and business relations, are strictly confidential and may not be made accessible to third parties without prior express consent from Ringele AG. The supplier shall transfer this obligation of secrecy to its employees and subcontractors.

4. Prices

The prices are fixed prices and include all ancillary costs, such as, freight, insurance and packaging. All changes to the prices must be made in writing and shall come into effect no earlier than 1 month after their release.

5. Place of performance

The place of performance for the supplier's services is Pratteln. The use and risk of the goods shall be transferred to Ringele AG upon delivery of the goods at the place of performance.

6. Quality requirements

The supplier shall take the appropriate measures to verify that the products delivered to Ringele AG comply with the respective specification. When requested, the supplier must be able to demonstrate that he has implemented the appropriate quality assurance measures. A separate agreement is made for the documentation of the quality controls in an initial sample inspection report or in test records.

Within the framework of audits, the supplier allows Ringele AG to determine whether the quality assurance measures meet the requirements of Ringele AG. In this regard, the supplier grants access to documents pertaining to the subject of quality and access to his premises. Customers of Ringele AG, for whom the supplier is appointed as a sub-contractor, are also permitted access to the documents pertaining to quality and access to the premises within the framework of audits.

7. Conflict material

The parts supplied must not contain any of the following materials from the Democratic Republic of the Congo or its neighbouring countries: Tantalum, tin, tungsten and gold.

8. List of banned substances

The list of banned substances referring to hazardous substances AAU.5614 is an integral part of these Terms of Purchase.



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9. Shipping

The purchased goods are transported at the expense and risk of the supplier. Each consignment must be accompanied by a delivery note indicating Ringele AG's order number and item number. The goods must be marked in such a way that they can be identified on the basis of the details on the delivery note.

10. Payment

Unless agreed otherwise, the payment period is 30 days after receipt of invoice and goods, with 2% discount or 60 days net. Complaints about the goods entitle Ringele AG to postpone their payment.

11. Delivery date

The agreed delivery dates must be adhered to down to the specific day in accordance with the order. Ringele AG will accept 2 days advance delivery.

12. Warranty

The supplier guarantees the complete functionality of the goods and respectively that they have been produced according to the specifications and drawings. Ringele AG is not obliged to inspect the goods. The warranty period is 12 months after the delivery. If there is a fault, the fastest and safest way to rectify it will be selected. If the supplier is not in a position to rectify the fault, he shall assume the costs incurred.

13. Environmental protection

The supplier shall maintain a level of order and cleanliness on his own premises that is in keeping with that of the industry and guarantees to comply with all the environmental laws. All dangerous goods shall be stored in such a way that only trained personnel can access them and to minimise the risk of accidents. We expect the supplier to avoid environmental pollution wherever possible, to save on resources and optimise his energy consumption.

14. Severance clause

If any individual provisions in these terms of delivery are or become invalid or unenforceable, the validity of the remaining terms of delivery shall remain unaffected.
